Walk through the **bridge** onto the plane

Air stairs in an old airport

Gate

Aircraft/airplane

Seat number

Put your luggage into the overhead compartment

Carry-on baggage

Aisle seat

Middle seat (too crammed, uncomfortable, you don't have enough space)

Armrest (between seats)

Window **shade** (when it is too bright you may have to pull down the window sill)
