# Simple Present verb 'to be' (essere)

- I am
- You are
- He is
- She is
- It is
- We are
- You are
- They are

I am not

You are not

He is not

She is not

It is not

We are not

You are not

They are not

are + not = aren't

is + not = isn't



# VERB “TO BE” (ser o estar)

## Interrogative form / Short answers

Am I ...?	Yes, you <b>are</b> . / No, you <b>aren't</b> .
Are you ...?	Yes, I <b>am</b> . / No, I'm <b>not</b> .
Is he ...?	Yes, he <b>is</b> . / No, he <b>isn't</b> .
Is she ...?	Yes, she <b>is</b> . / No, she <b>isn't</b> .
Is it ...?	Yes, it <b>is</b> . / No, it <b>isn't</b> .
Are we ...?	Yes, we <b>are</b> . / No, we <b>aren't</b> .
Are you ...?	Yes, we <b>are</b> . / No, we <b>aren't</b> .
Are they ...?	Yes, they <b>are</b> . / No, they <b>aren't</b> .
