Have vs Have got

VERB TO HAVE GOT

PRESENT

AFFIRMATIVE

-

?

I have got	I've got	I haven't got	Have I got...?
You have got	You've got	You haven't got	Have you got...?
He has got She has got It has got	He's got She's got It's got	He hasn't got She hasn't got It hasn't got	Has he got...? Has she got...? Has it got...?
We have got You have got They have got	We've got You've got They've got	We haven't got You haven't got They haven't got	Have we got...? Have you got...? Have they got...?

Verb “to have”: Present

-when used as a main verb-

Pronoun	Affirmative	Negative
I	I have	I don't have
you	you have	you don't have
he	he has	he doesn't have
she	she has	she doesn't have
it	it has	it doesn't have
we	we have	we don't have
they	they have	they don't have
you	you have	you don't have

have o have got

have oppure have got per parlare di:

ciò che si possiede: I have a house in Spain/I've got a house in Spain.

per parlare dei propri familiari: Sara has a brother/ Sara's got a brother.

per descrivere le persone: I have brown eyes/I've got brown eyes.

per dire che non ci si sente bene: I have a headache/I've got a headache.

have

si usa solamente have per parlare:

dei pasti: I usually have breakfast at 7.

delle vacanze: I had a wonderful holiday last year.

e con verbi che descrivono delle azioni: I have a shower every morning.

per il passato e per il futuro solo HAVE:

I had a headache e non ~~I had got a headache.~~
