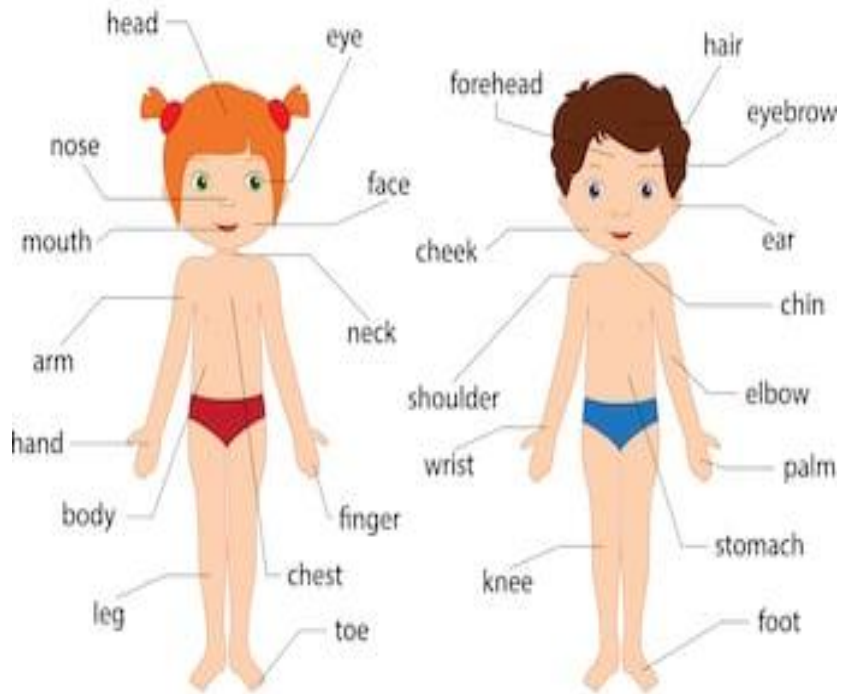
Giraffes are incredible animals. Giraffes live in the Savannah, in Africa.

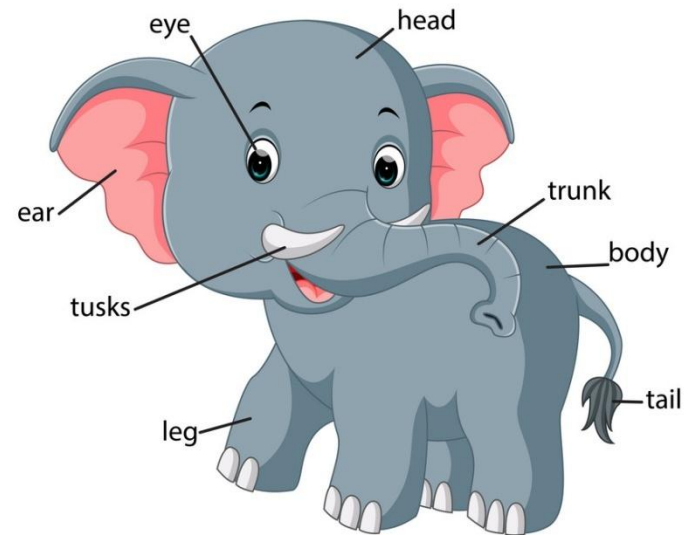
